

### **SOTA/Board PD Fund Q&A**

## Can I apply now for a conference for next

Yes! The funding period for next year is now open for any activities taking place from October 2023 to June 2024. You may be approved for funding for up to TWO activities per year.

#### Can I apply for a summer PD activity?

The application deadline for all professional development activities, including tuition, that take place in July, August, or September was June 1<sup>st</sup>. As this date has passed, you are not able to apply for a professional development activity for this summer.

#### what should I include for my rationale?

The following rationale must be included in your application in order for your request to be considered for funding:

i) How does attending this PD inform your practice?ii) How does attending this PD impact your work in Seven Oaks?

An incomplete rationale can result in the denial of a PD request.

#### Does the PD Fund cover tuition?

Yes! The Fund reimburses 1/3 eligible tuition from an accredited post-secondary institution up to a maximum of \$500 per 3 credit hours.

Fatumah Mbabaali has worked in Seven Oaks School Division as a classroom teacher, learning support teacher, vice principal and principal. She is retiring this year from her position as Principal at Collicutt School. Three decades ago, Fatumah fled war-torn Uganda and settled in Winnipeg. Her research focuses on the sense of belonging among war-affected refugee youth during their pre-migration and post-migration, as well as factors that impact their sense of belonging during resettlement.
