- Medical expenses that are NOT related to an emergency medical situation are not covered
- Emergencies related to an unstable, pre-existing medical condition(s) are NOT covered. When an insured person is under active care for a chronic condition, emergency services do NOT include any treatment related to that condition outside your province of residence. Consider additional healthcare coverage if you or a dependant is traveling with known health issues.
- Expenses related to trip cancellation, trip interruption and loss of luggage are NOT covered

### Travel Assist Coverage

Your Group Benefits plan provides coverage for emergency medical assistance while travelling outside your Province\* up to the maximum number of days stated in your Group Benefits Plan Booklet.

## Allianz Global Assistance administers Equitable Life's Travel Assist benefits.

Allianz has an international network of medical facilities, transportation providers, medical correspondents and multilingual administrative agents who provide assistance for medical, legal and most travel-related emergencies 24-hours a day, seven days a week.



# In an out-of-province medical emergency, Allianz Global Assistance will provide:

#### Medical assistance

- Direct you to the best, pre-qualified emergency care facility that is appropriate for your condition.
- Monitor your condition and ensure you receive proper emergency medical care.
- Maintain frequent contact with you, your treating physician, and your family at home.

#### Medical transportation

- If medically necessary, arrangements will be made to transport you to the nearest local hospital.
- In the event of a medical emergency, medical transportation arrangements will be made for your return to your province of residence.

#### Payment arrangements

If you call Allianz Global Assistance before incurring an emergency medical expense, every effort will be made to arrange treatment without the need for a cash payment or deposit. Travel Assist will then arrange and coordinate payment on your behalf so you can avoid paying foreign hospitals – in cash – prior to leaving.

#### Additional services

- Direct you to a local pharmacy if you need to replace lost medication
- Assist with lost documents
